NOTES, HINTS & TIPS:

- Suitable for use with incandescent, halogen and ceramic heat bulbs which have the E27 Edison type screw fitting.
- Reptile One recommends installation by a qualified electrician.
- For safety reasons, never use a globe that is rated at more than 200W with this ceramic fitting. Reptile One recommends a maximum of 150W light globe be used with this fitting for regular use.
- Never allow the ceramic light fitting to be hung above water or any other body of liquid which can conduct electricity.
- Ensure you use a wire mesh cage over the fitting to protect your reptiles from exposure to bare globes, which can burn your reptile if it came into contact with the hot light globe.
- Regularly check & clean the fitting for dust or dirt build up, which can shorten the lifespan of your fitting and globes.
- Reptile One will not be held accountable or liable for the mis-use of this product. Any appliance which conducts electricity and generates heat must be used with caution. Seek professional advice prior to use and never allow young children to play with or handle this appliance without adult supervision.
- Always switch off the light fitting and unplug the light fitting from the power-point before performing any maintenance on the fitting or removing light globes. Do not remove light globes which are still hot to touch.
- Regularly inspect the whole unit, including the ceramic fitting, power cord and on/off switch to ensure that all of the components are in good working condition. We recommend a monthly inspection at a minimum. If you find that any part of the unit is broken, loose or not in good working condition, immediate cease using the fitting and either seek professional advice on repairs of the unit, or discard the unit and replace it with a new one.
- When using any 240V electrical item, always ensure your safety and never take any unnecessary risks. Electricity is extremely dangerous.
